## Abstract:

Research Link Australia (RLA) is designed to bridge the information gap between research, industry, business, and government to enable more impactful innovation. To achieve this, RLA will need a simple, safe, sustainable method to gain better quality collaborative data from universities and to find a secure method to access that information.

In Phase1 of a three year ARDC funded program, Griffith, SCU and UTS have partnered with Digital Science to prototype the data provisioning method for universities to provide their collaborative data to RLA. In turn, the RLA data was provided to each university to develop use cases. This presentation discusses the collaborative data provisioning project and the use cases of each institution. The roadmap of the RLA is also presented.
